



MARTIN COUNTY TAX DEPARTMENT OPENS to PUBLIC TUESDAY MAY 26, 2020

Ruth "Ski" Pietruszewski, Martin County Tax Collector, proudly announces opening the tax department to the public on May 26th at 8am. The tax department handles: Property tax, Tangible Personal Property, Tourist Development Tax, Business Tax Receipts, animal tags, and alarm permits.

- Only the person conducting business will be allowed in the office
- You must wear a face mask or face shield to enter the office and wear it while inside
- Limited to 4 clients at a time in tax department

- We've designed barriers with protective shields to provide no physical contact between the clerks and the customers for when we reopen to the public to keep both constituents and our staff safe and make them feel comfortable that they are protected. We've followed the Governor's safe, step-by-step guidelines, DOH, CDC, and OSHA recommendations.
- We ask to NOT pay by cash if possible (viruses can live on paper bills)
- Payment can be made by check or E-check (we can do for you in our system), or use Apple, Samsung, or Google pay. Payment can be made by credit card/debit card (card processor charges a fee which we get no part of)
