The re-opening of FULL SERVICES (excluding TSA, TWIC, Hazmat, and Concealed Weapon Permits) at the Stuart, Palm City and Hobe Sound locations. The Indiantown branch office will remain closed until June 8th.

Services are temporarily limited to Martin County residents

IMPORTANT CUSTOMER SAFETY PROTOCOLS ARE IN PLACE AT THE MARTIN COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR’S OFFICE.

Please do not come into the office if you are experiencing: Fever, extended cough, shortness of breath, or have been exposed to anyone with COVID 19.

For your safety and the safety of others, only one customer at a time is permitted to enter the office, limiting it to 10 customers at a time. Only the person conducting business will be allowed in the office. All customers are required to wear a mask or face covering (scarf, bandana, shield) while inside.

We maintain social distancing within the office by:

- Providing barriers with protective shields to provide no physical contact between constituents and staff to ensure a comfortable protected environment.
- Providing adequate markings to maintain social distancing while on line and within the office
