Ruth “Ski” Pietruszewski, Martin County Tax Collector, proudly announces re-opening **FULL SERVICES** June 8<sup>st</sup> at 8am at our Indiantown branch office. Please stay home if you are sick, have a fever or cough, or exposed to someone who has COVID-19.

- Only the person conducting business will be allowed in the office
- A face mask or face shield must be worn while inside
- Social distancing will be practiced inside and outside the building
- We ask to NOT pay by cash if possible (viruses can live on paper bills)
- Payment can be made by check or E-check (we can do for you in our system), or use Apple, Samsung, or Google pay
- Payment can be made by credit card/debit card (card processor charges a fee which we get no part of)
- We’ve designed barriers with protective shields to provide no physical contact between the clerks and the customers to keep both constituents and our staff safe and make them feel comfortable that they are protected. We’ve followed the Governor’s safe, step-by-step guidelines, DOH, CDC, and OSHA recommendations.
